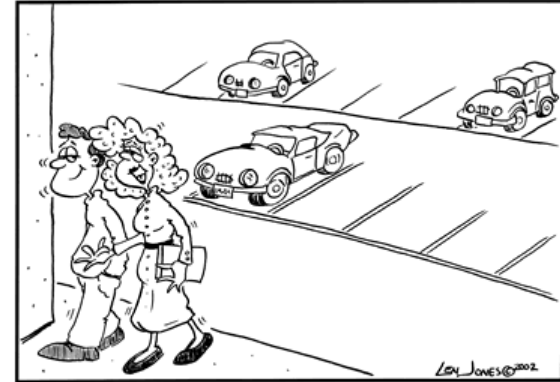
### Rafting Trip
